

# Pre, During and Follow-Up Visit Activities – Teacher Notes

## **SHOPPER 13 – The Edam Is Stranded**

Visitors collect the items in the shopper.

### **To Boldly Go . . . Create Station**

A creative interactive where visitors use tracing paper, pencils and outlines of rocket parts to design a spacecraft for the future.

### **Keeping an Eye on the Planets**

Viewmaster type interactives act as Wallace's 'look out' to explore the planets. They feature facts and photographs along with factual information about the planets.

### **Is There Anybody Out There?**

Profile satellites and space communication inventions. Experiment with voice altering equipment.

### **Everyday Objects**

Quiz involving everyday objects originally invented to aid space travel and space living.

### **Tools for Exploring Space**

Examine instruments for exploring space such as heat flow probes, seismometers, magnetometers, and robotic technology. The following ideas for pre, during and post visit activities provide opportunities for your pupils to follow in the footsteps of Wallace and Gromit in their exploration of the space and collect evidence to help develop their knowledge and understanding of the Solar System.

Adaptable activity sheets are provided and background information and word bank should be used to support pupils in completing their work.

Quiz sheets (and answers!) are provided for both Key Stage 2 and 3 pupils. These can be completed during the visit or used as a follow up activity to review what was learnt.
